SHIPPED in good Order, and well conditioned, by
Solomon McCombs in and upon the good *Schooner* called
the *Ethan Allen* whereof is Master for this present Voyage,
Soloman McCombs and now riding at anchor in the Port of
Port of Spain and bound for *Baltimore*

To say,

Forty one hogsheads of Molasses
And fifteen hogsheads of Sugar

BEING marked and numbered as in the Margin, and
are to be delivered in the like good Order and well
conditioned, at the aforesaid Port of *Baltimore* (the danger
of the Seas only excepted) unto *Ambrose Clarke* or to *his*
Assigns, he or they paying Freight for the said goods,
nothing being owners property

and Average accustomed,
