

Know all men by these Presents,

That we *Life Wilson* at present of the City of Baltimore,
Mariner and Master of the *Ship Edwin* and

W. R. Adair & Tho. B. Adair

all of the same City, are held and firmly bound to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, lawful money of the United States, to be paid to the Mayor and City Council aforesaid, or their successors, to which payment well and truly to be made, we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally by these presents.

Sealed with our Seals this *twentieth* day of *August* in the
year *eighteen hundred and thirty four*

Whereas, the said Master hath, on this *20* day of *August* 183*4*
from *Belfast* arrived, and entered said vessel at the Custom House
in the port of Baltimore, and in the said vessel brought *Nancy Miller*
an alien passenger, named and described in the
written report made to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by the said Master.

Now the condition of the above obligation is such, That if the above
bounden *L. Wilson, W. R. Adair & T. B. Adair* shall indemnify and save
harmless the said Mayor and City Council, and the Trustees of the Poor for Baltimore
City and County, from all and every expense and charge which shall or may be incurred
at any time within two years from the date of the entry of the said vessel at the Port
of Baltimore, for the support and maintenance of the said *Nancy Miller*
imported as aforesaid, then the above obligation to
be void, else to remain in full force and virtue in law.
